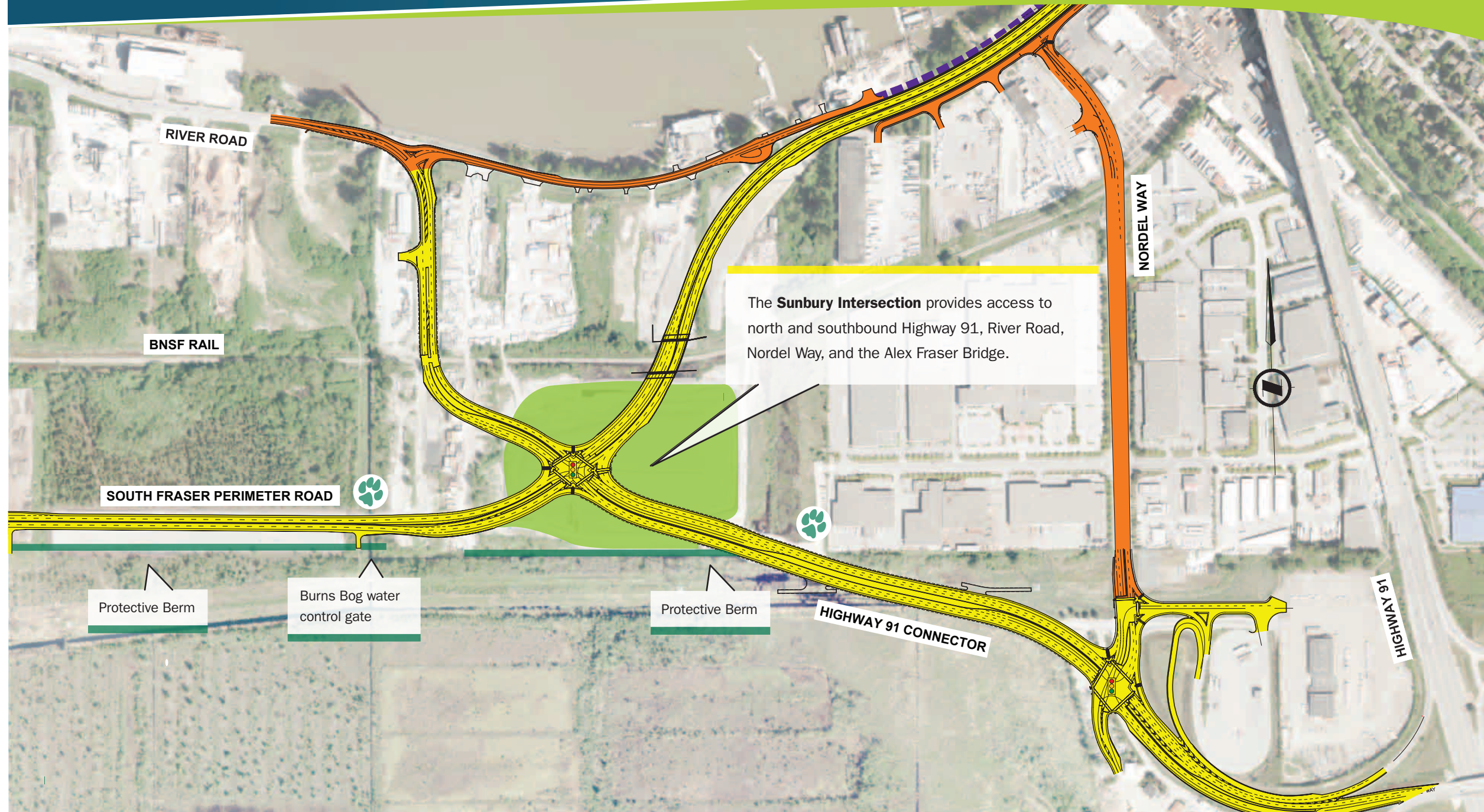


SOUTH FRASER PERIMETER ROAD PROJECT



The **Sunbury Intersection** provides access to north and southbound Highway 91, River Road, Nordel Way, and the Alex Fraser Bridge.

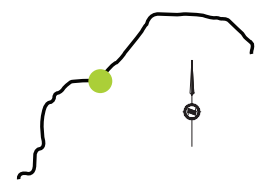
Key Features of This Section

The SFPR travels adjacent to **Burns Bog** in some locations. The project includes numerous enhancements to help manage Burns Bog, which is a critically important and highly valued environmental protection area. Ongoing work continues with the Corporation of Delta, Burns Bog Management Committee, and the Ministry of Environment to protect Burns Bog. This includes:

- Drainage infrastructure, including water control gates and a water balance model to help actively manage water levels in and around Burns Bog.
- Wildlife crossing structures allow for movement of wildlife across the corridor.
- Mineral water leaching into the bog has been reduced by 95%.
- Closing adjacent landfills has increased the protection for Burns Bog by decreasing the potential for leachate and fire.
- Closing adjacent landfills has allowed for rehabilitation and industrial development of the area.
