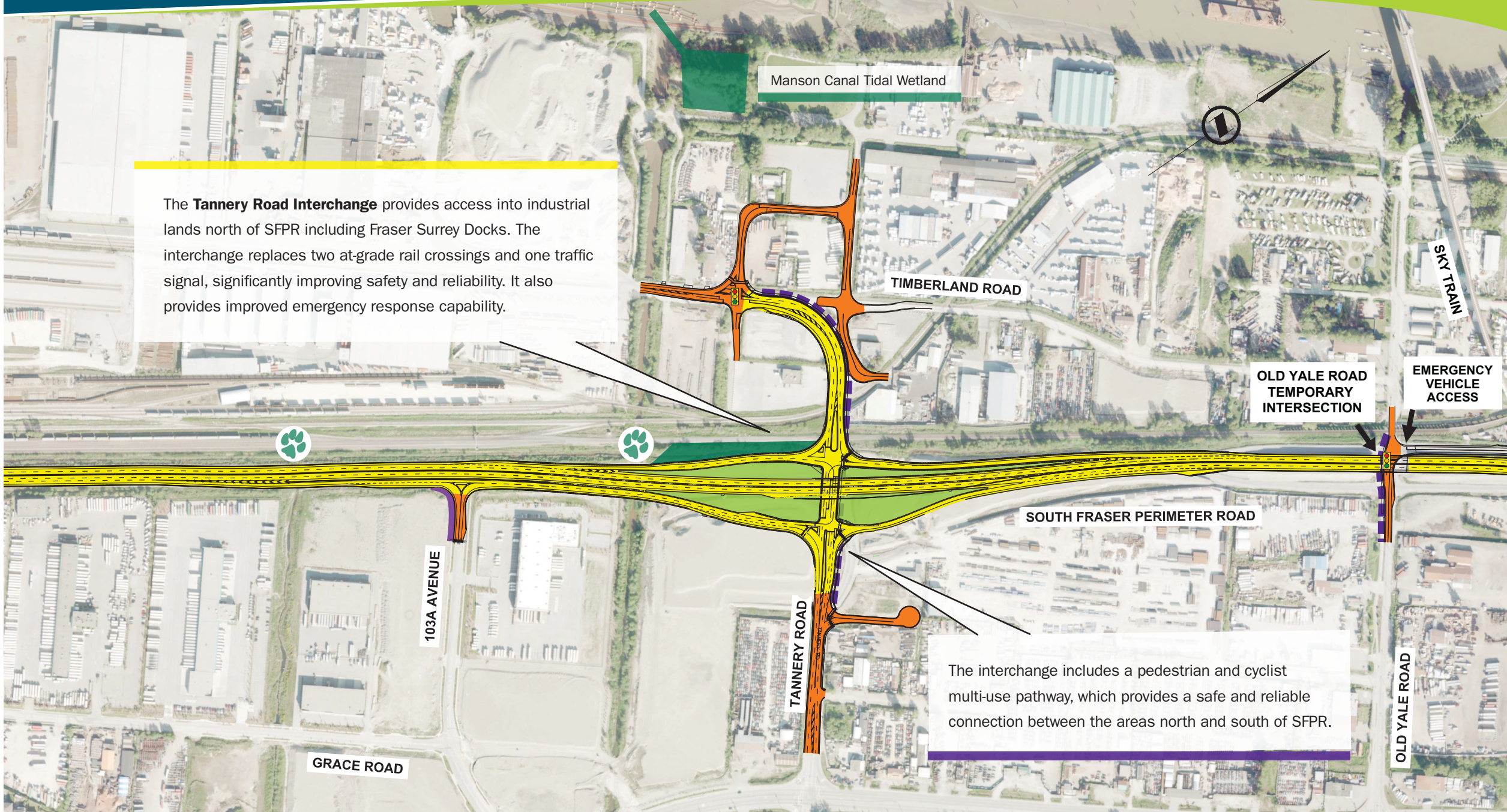
Key Features of This Section

At **Old Yale Road**, short-term improvements include a temporary intersection connecting to SFPR. The area has been protected for a future interchange, when TransLink's plans for the Pattullo Bridge replacement are complete.

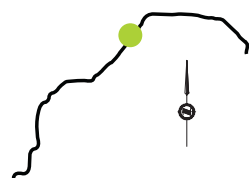
As part of SFPR's environmental enhancements, the **Manson Canal Tidal Wetland** fish and wildlife enhancement site within Tannery Road Park converted low-value habitat into high-quality intertidal and riparian habitat that provides a rearing home for young salmon and other fish. The wetland also includes cattails and other native marsh plants, and riparian planting with native shrubs and trees has taken place. Tidal marsh habitat is a particularly valuable ecological feature within the lower Fraser River.

The **Tannery Road Interchange** provides access into industrial lands north of SFPR including Fraser Surrey Docks. The interchange replaces two at-grade rail crossings and one traffic signal, significantly improving safety and reliability. It also provides improved emergency response capability.

The interchange includes a pedestrian and cyclist multi-use pathway, which provides a safe and reliable connection between the areas north and south of SFPR.
