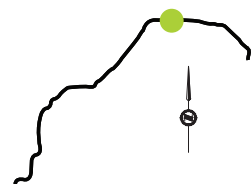
Project Benefits

- More than 3500 long-term jobs in Surrey.
- New municipal development opportunities – through efficient access to designated commercial and industrial areas in Delta and Surrey.
- Time savings – travel times will be reduced by up to one-third.
- SFPR provides convenient and reliable access between the Golden Ears Bridge, Port Mann Bridge, Pattullo Bridge, Alex Fraser Bridge and George Massey Tunnel, to help efficiently reroute traffic in the event of a significant incident as well as to provide improved emergency response.
- Fast, efficient route to untolled alternatives to the Port Mann Bridge, providing improved travel route choice.

The **T-intersection between SFPR and 136th Street** will maintain the connection to CN Rail's Thornton Yard and local businesses. From 136th Street, SFPR continues eastward, passing underneath the Port Mann Bridge. The area was **landscaped** with natural and local native vegetation.
