

SOUTH FRASER PERIMETER ROAD PROJECT



A new **wildlife crossing** will allow local wildlife to cross underneath SFPR and provide easy access to Bon Accord Creek.

Environmental enhancements at Bon Accord Creek will improve an existing salmon stream. **Off-channel ponds** will provide rearing habitat for juvenile salmon, while plantings of trees and cedar snags along the shore will benefit a variety of local bird species. Enhancements also include ponds for amphibians, songbird nest boxes, and bat roost boxes.

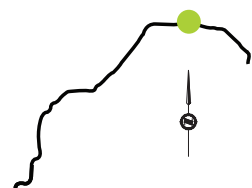
South Fraser Perimeter Road continues under Port Mann Bridge

Bon Accord Creek ponds

A six metre-wide right-of-way is being provided to accommodate a **future multi-use pathway** south of SFPR between the Port Mann Bridge and Golden Ears Way.

Project Benefits

- Improve safety and reliability.
- Improved international trade competitiveness – providing better access to major trade gateways such as Deltaport, Fraser Surrey Docks, CN Intermodal Yard, Canada/US Border crossings, and faster, more reliable travel for port traffic.
- Improved access to Vancouver Island via the Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal, benefitting local and international tourism.
- Improved regional transportation network – this project completes a key corridor that has been planned for more than 30 years and provides improved connections between Highways 1, 15, 91, 99, 17, and related Fraser River crossings.
